Role Purpose:

To support the Students' Union in the delivery of Welcome Week events for new and existing students at the University of Aberdeen.

Core Duties and Responsibilities:

- To assist in the set-up, dismantle and clean-up of SU events
- To support the SU where needed and respond to final requests
- To help organise equipment and freebies during SU events
- To provide technical support at SU events if/when required
- To capture content at SU events for the SU social media

Additional Information:
